To All Developers and Engineers,

Harvest-Monrovia Water, Sewer and Fire Protection Authority Inc.,(Authority), effective immediately will not schedule a pre-construction meeting with any Engineer, Developer or Contractor without an approved set of drawings stamped and signed by the Authority.

Due to the number of problems that are being caused by prints being released for bids before all changes have been made and approved by the Authority has made this necessary. Starting immediately all construction prints shall have a place on the title sheet for the approval of construction by the Authority. If the prints have not been approved, stamped and signed no construction will begin.

It is the responsibility of the Developer and/or the Engineer to supply the Authority with the necessary drawings to review and make changes. It is the responsibility of the Developer and/or Engineer to make the necessary changes and return to the Authority a set of drawings with changes for review and approval.

The Authority will make every effort to have the final review and approval back to the Engineer within 2 weeks after drawings were received.
